And, here are some more benefits which have been noted by numerous GCSEPod Leads:

- 1) Your role as GCSEPod Lead can act as evidence towards your own professional development and performance management, including meeting and exceeding Teacher Standards; contributing towards School Improvement Plan priorities and improving/maintaining Ofsted grading.
- 2) If you are responsible for e-Learning or a VLE at your school, your role can extend your reach and impact. You may use GCSEPod as a tool to improve colleagues' confidence with IT/mobile technology whilst raising usage and awareness of your VLE.
- 3) Many GCSEPod Leads have written action research projects as a result of their work with GCSEPod and utilised these within their post-graduate qualification (e.g. Masters).
- 4) If you are responsible for managing funds for specific groups of 'hard to reach' students and the terms of the funding require demonstrable impact (e.g. Pupil Premium), you may wish to use GCSEPod to evidence your efforts to engage students in a new, fresh way and utilise the built-in GCSEPod reporting facilities to monitor usage and
