# How are form groups arranged?

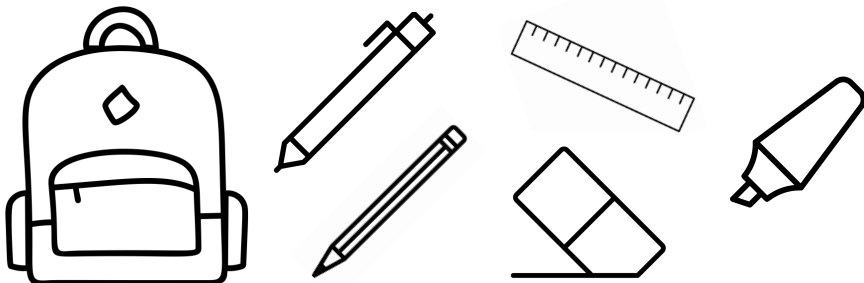
- Close liaison with primary schools

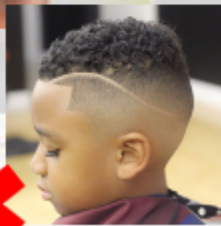
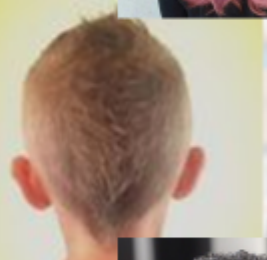

Students lose break times and lunchtimes until they come to school in the correct footwear or with the correct hair style.





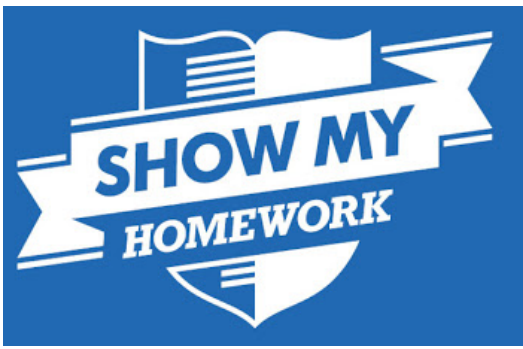

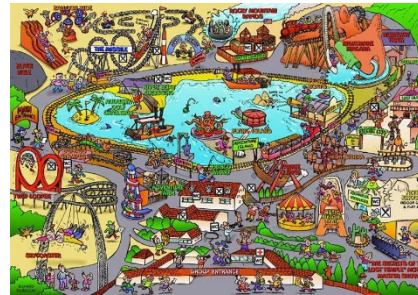
